What are Members' Resources

While we try to make CORC resources available to anyone who is interested, we appreciate that there are some which are more applicable to CORC members. These include essential documents and information such as:

- useful information on the background to CORC,
- the CORC Toolkit,
- the CORC-YouthInMind and Consultation Questionnaire databases,
- CORC updates,
- minutes and documents from Committee, Research, Implementers and Members Forum meetings,
- information on future research.

There is also a discussion forum on the website - a space where those from member organisations can come together to ask questions, discuss issues and support one another. ♦♦♦♦

We encourage you to make the most of the Members' resources. In particular the Forum is your place to ask questions. Don't be shy! Chances are someone else is wondering or has wondered the same thing and they might have ideas you can use. This is a learning collaboration and there is no such thing as a stupid question. ♦♦♦♦

Who can register?

Anyone who works for a CORC member service. You don't have to be a CORC Member Rep or an implementer and there is no limit to the number of people who have registered from a service. If you are interested in outcome monitoring then we would encourage you to register.

What should I do if I have already registered for the old CORC website?

All you need to do is contact us with your username (or name and service if you can't remember your username) and we will re-assign you a password. You can change this password in the Forum section once you have logged in.





How do I register?

Please enter this information to avoid delays in activating your registration!

Once you have registered, please wait at least 24 hours before trying to access the Members' resources. Your registration needs to be activated by us first to confirm your access to these member-only resources. If you need access immediately, please contact us and we will activate your registration as soon as possible. It is very important that you identify yourself in your registration by entering your **name**, **CORC Service** and **Occupation** as we get spammers trying to register. If you don't provide this information we will need to contact you to confirm it which will delay activating your registration and mean that you might not have access to the Members' resources until several days after you register.





Common questions with registration and accessing the Members' Resources

My email address is “already assigned to another user”

Had you previously registered for the old CORC Forum? Email or phone us with your name, username and CORC service and we will check if you are already registered. If so, we will assign you a password which you can change once you have successfully logged in.

I can't log on

Make sure you have entered your username and password correctly. Passwords are case-sensitive so if you have the Caps Lock button on when your password is in lower-case you will not be able to log in.

It may be that your registration has not been activated. Please contact us and we will do this as soon as possible.

I have registered but have forgotten my username and/or password

Not a problem! Just get in touch by phone, email or by clicking the “I forgot my password” link at the log in screen and we will find out your username or reset your password.

Can other people in my service use my username and password to access the Members' resources?

Yes they can but we would rather they register separately. There are several reasons for this:

If they have their own username and password they can choose which topics to watch and be receive emails when new messages are posted.

The CORC Central Team can see the types of people from each service who are interested in learning more about the CORC protocol. This helps us develop information and resources which will be of the most help.

There is no limit to the number of people who register from a single service.
