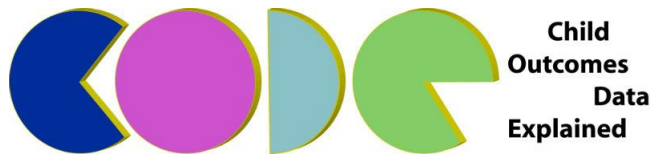

CODE Updates

- CODE will periodically be updated to incorporate new measures/make minor alterations – if CODE is on a computer that can connect to the internet, it will automatically update to the newest version upon start-up. If not, you will need to manually download new versions
- New versions will be posted for download on the CODE install webpage
- CORC will e-mail all members when new updates to CODE are available – make sure we have up-to-date contacts for your service!
- CODE has recently been updated to be compliant with the newest CYP IAPT data specification

New features of CODE v.4

- Some changes/new features to the newest version of CODE are:
 - Cases can now have both an NHS ID and a locally assigned patient ID
 - Added ESQ free-text responses for child/parent ESQ
 - Added the Kessler 10 (K10) measures
 - Added the Group Session Rating Scale (GSRS) measure
 - Added the CORE-10 Measure
 - Added the YP CORE measure
 - Added the WEMWBS measure
 - Added the EDE-A (Eating disorder examination questionnaire – adolescent)

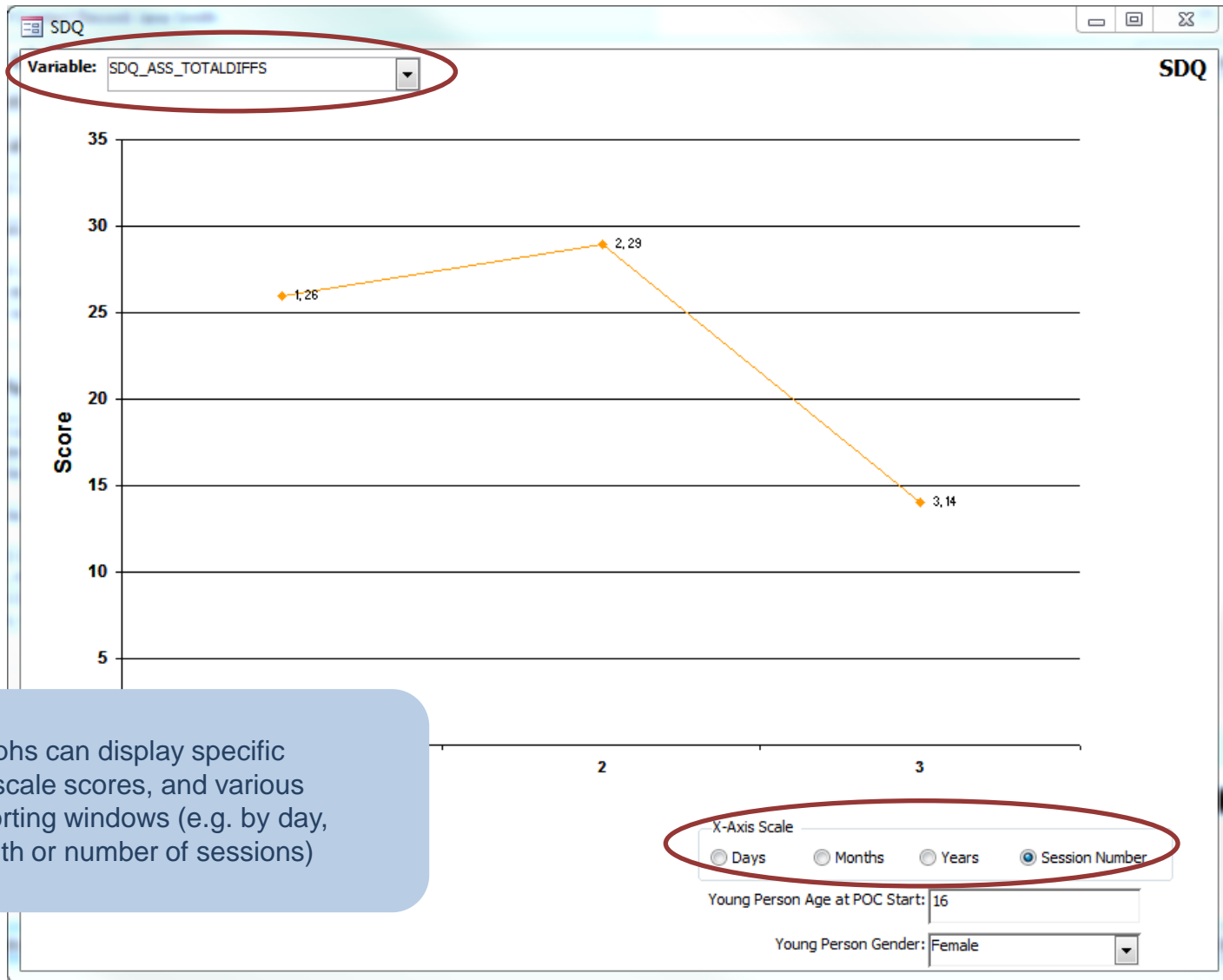
